TASK DETAILS:

Set Up: Rest Stop Lead will have detailed instructions regarding set up for rest stop area.

- Set up and placement of tables
- Set up trash cans, recycle bins and buckets of beverages
- Arrange food/snack products to be ready for serving
- Placement of rest stop signage

Rest Stop Service:

- Prepare food (make sandwiches, cut fruit in half, etc)
- Replenish supplies as they run low for Trekkers
- Monitor traffic flow in and out of rest stop

Clean Up:

- Clean up and load all supplies into Rest Stop Truck
- Gather trash and recyclables and leave them in designated area determined by Rest Stop Lead
- Assist Volunteer Lead with all other clean up tasks

1. **Report directly to your Rest Stop on your first day of service.**
2. Locate your Volunteer Lead to receive your t-shirt, meal bracelet and name badge.
3. Volunteer Lead will give you specific assignment for the day.
