TASK LOCATIONS:

Friday - Along the Trek route between Sunday River Resort and UMF

Saturday - Along the Trek route between UMF and Colby College

Sunday - Along the Trek route between Colby College and Belfast

TASK DETAILS:

You will be assigned to drive and monitor a specific section of the Trek route each day. A ham radio operator volunteer will be assigned to ride with you each day to act as communications with other SAGs, rest stops and the finish line to assist you with performing your duties.

As a SAG vehicle you will be able to transport Trekkers and their bikes to the next forward rest stop for mechanical assistance or if they are physically unable to continue riding. You will have a cooler with cold beverages, first aid kit and bike pump to provide assistance for flat tires along the route.

Your ham radio operator will have communication with the medical team in the event that a Trekker requires immediate medical attention.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE AT THE TREK:

1. Your volunteer materials will be mailed to you prior to the Trek. You will receive the following: t-shirt, name badge, gas card, meal bracelet, route maps, vehicle pick up information and Trek magnet.
2. You will be required to pick up your SAG vehicle prior to the Trek. All pick up information will be communicated to you prior to the event.
3. All SAG drivers report to Sunday River Resort on Thursday, June 16th for a SAG & Ham volunteer meeting. You will be provided with a free overnight stay at Sunday River Resort that night.
4. Report to your designated meeting area with your ham radio volunteer on Friday morning and prepare to head out on the Trek route.
5. Have fun and enjoy meeting new people!

***If you are staying overnight at the Trek, please travel to fixed facility for the night (UMF or Colby College) to receive your overnight accommodation assignments. You will receive a campus map with your rooming assignment indicated on the map.**
