We educate our children to keep them healthy and tobacco-free.

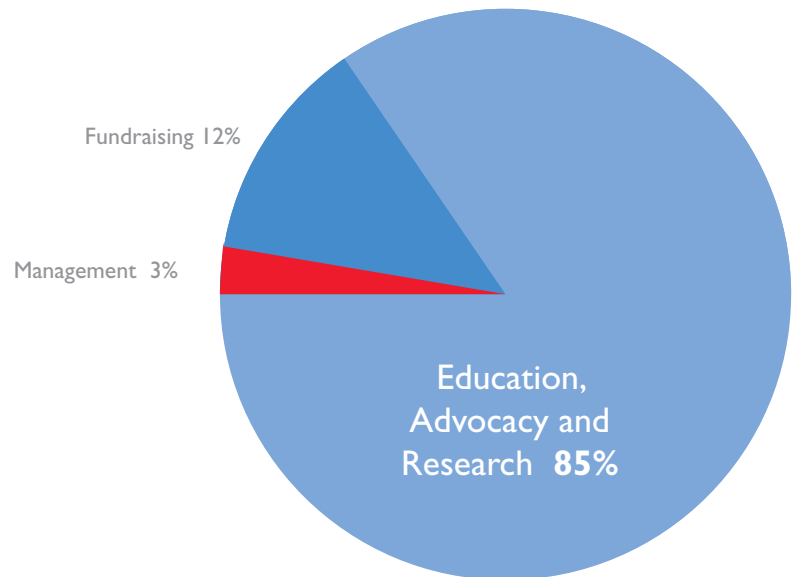
