



2015-16 Legislative Session Details

Despite record oil industry spending, landmark clean air and climate change legislation passed during the 2015-16 legislative session to maintain and expand California's leadership in protecting public health from harmful pollutants.

Oil Lobby spent over \$36 million in California's 2015-16 legislative session

- \$1.5 million per month nearly \$50,000 per day over the last two years
- Surpassed \$34 million spent in the prior session

Western States Petroleum Association (WSPA) top overall spender

- WSPA \$18.7 million spent in 2015-16
 - o Ranked #1 among all lobbying spenders this session

Chevron spent \$7 million in the 2015-16 session

- Chevron ranked #6 among all lobbyists in the current session
 - o \$3 million spent in 2016

\$133 million in California Oil Industry lobbying since the 2007-08 Session

- WSPA and Chevron accounted for over \$90 million (2/3 of total)
 - o WSPA: \$62 million over ten years
 - o Chevron: \$28 million over ten years
