



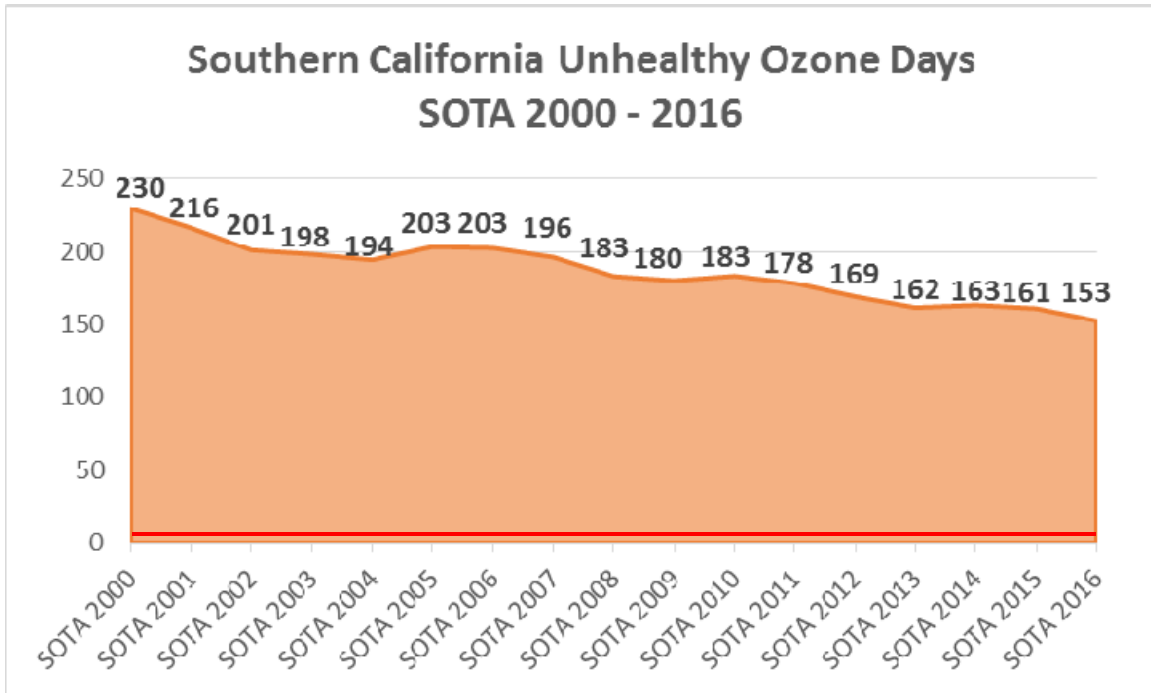
Ozone Pollution Trend Charts California Metropolitan Areas

The table below lists the California cities that ranked among the top 10 most ozone-polluted metropolitan areas in the nation in SOTA 2016 (2012-2014 air data).

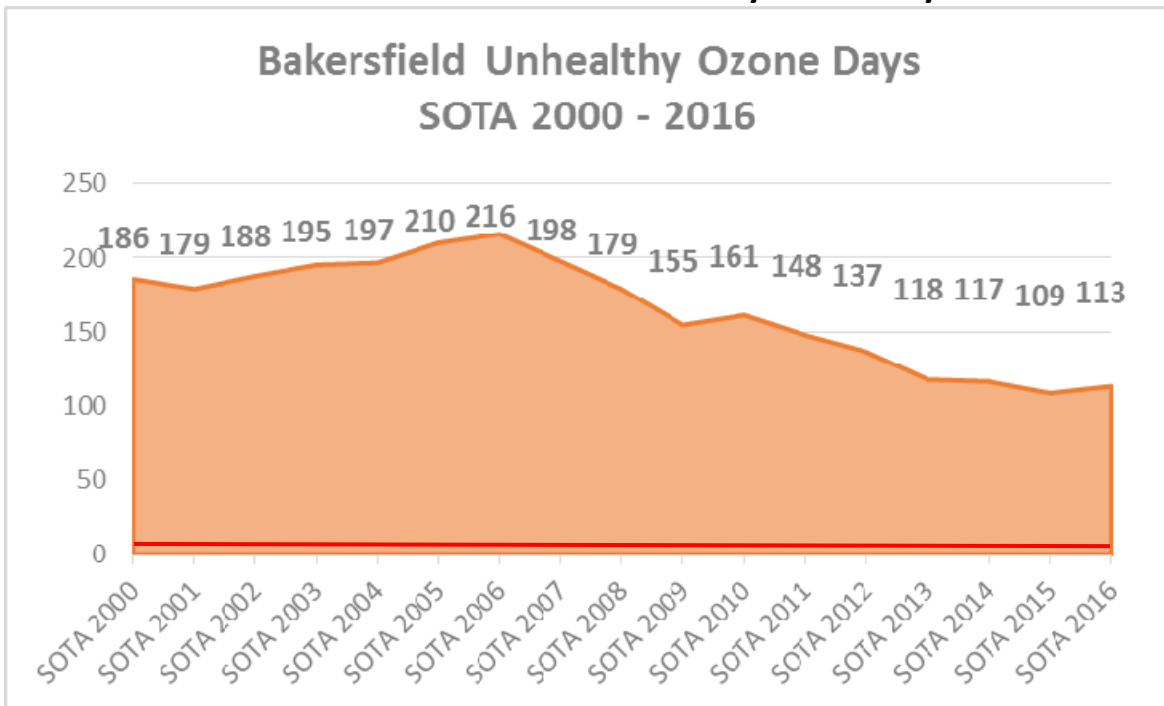

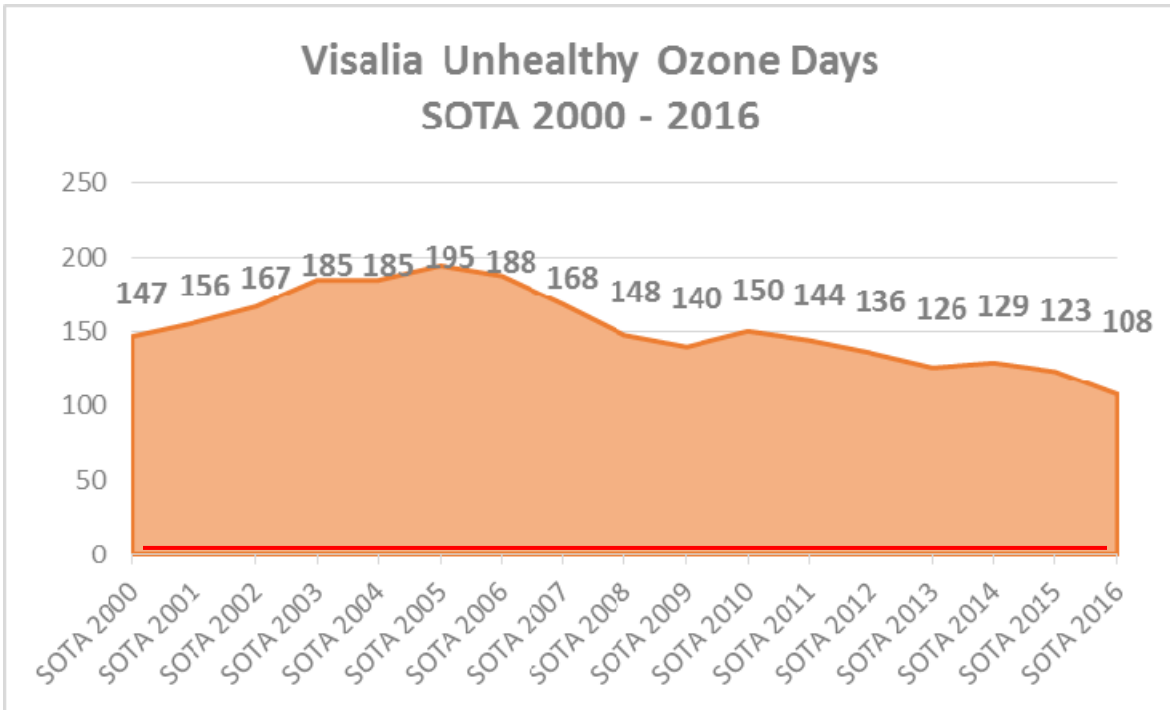
Los Angeles: #1 for Most Unhealthy Ozone Days



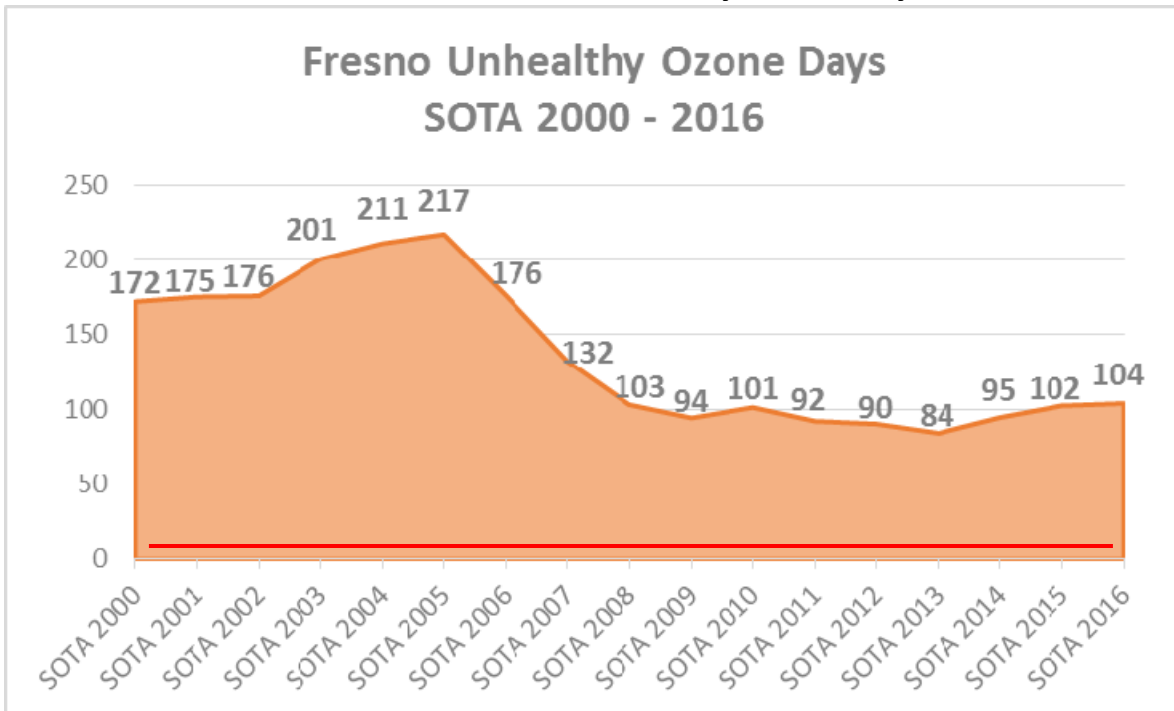
Bakersfield: #2 for Most Unhealthy Ozone Days



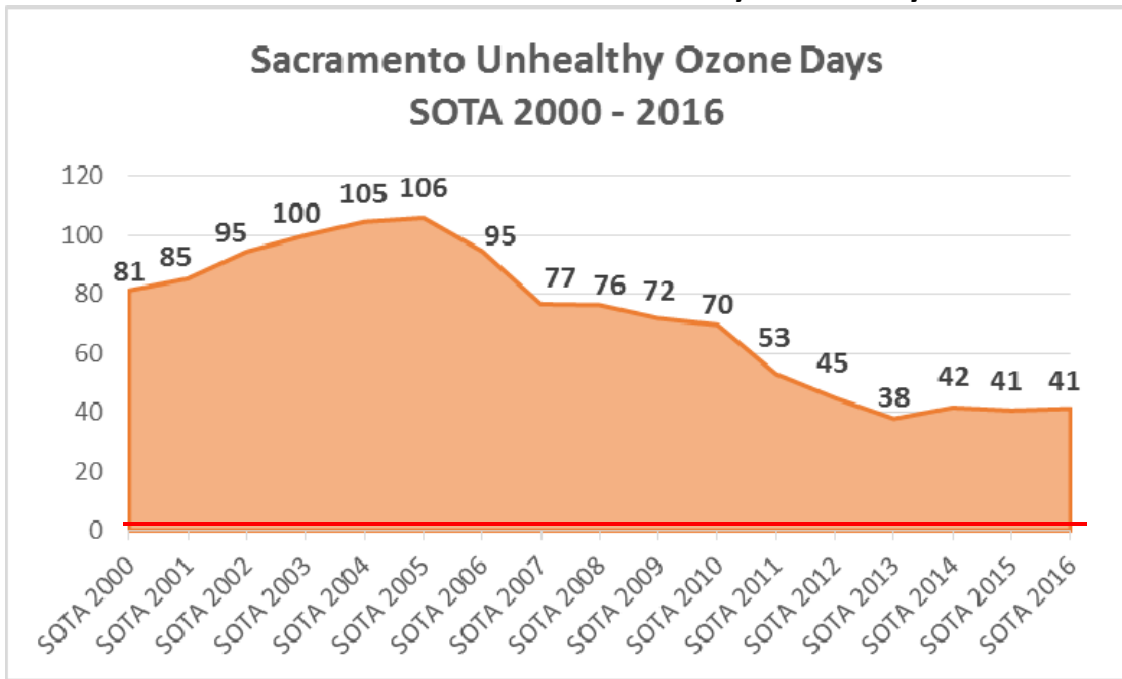
Visalia-Hanford: #3 for Most Unhealthy Ozone Days
