

## 2021 Indiana Radon Poster Contest

# **Opportunity for Students**

Radon is a colorless, odorless, tasteless, radioactive gas produced by the natural decay of uranium in the soil. Exposure to elevated radon levels increases the risk of developing lung cancer. Radon is the second leading cause of lung cancer. Approximately 1 in 3 homes tested have radon levels at or above the EPA action level of 4.0 pCi/L in Indiana. By participating in this activity, students will learn about radon and how to reduce their risk of exposure.

In order to spread the message about radon's health hazards, the Indiana State Department of Health along with the American Lung Association, host a statewide **Indiana Radon Poster Contest**. We are calling on Indiana citizens **ages 9-14** to create a radon poster that will increase public awareness of radon gas and encourage other Hoosiers to test their homes.

#### **Awards**

1<sup>st</sup> place winner will receive \$250 +\$250 for the school 2<sup>nd</sup> place winner will receive \$150 3<sup>rd</sup> place winner will receive \$100 School with most entries will receive \$250

## **Poster Guidelines**

### Poster topics:

- What is radon?
- Where does radon come from?
- How does radon get into our homes?
- Radon can cause lung cancer
- Test your home for radon

### What the judges are looking for:

- Accuracy of poster content
- Correct spelling
- Reproducibility of poster
- Originality of poster (Does not resemble a past winner)
- Poster is aesthetically pleasing

## Requirements:

- Be original
- Student's name is not on the front
- Topic and title must be on the Artwork Entry Form (1 copy included!)
- White paper 12 x 18 and 8.5 x 11 sizes are preferred, but all sizes will be accepted
- Can be created with crayon, markers, paint, collage, photographs or computer graphics
- Lettering and message should be large enough to reproduce well.
- All pencil markings erased
- Copyrighted characters, product logos and trademarked or brand names cannot be used
