

Creating an Account

Creating an Account continued


- A pop-up screen will appear with information to be completed.

- In the 'Notifications' pop-up, click on 'Your profile is incomplete'.






- In the 'Manage Groups' section, select 'Indiana' if it is not already selected.

- Type the training plan number 5338 in the search box.




 Click on the training plan 'IDOH TB Basics and TB Tests Used to Identify TB Infection' that will be shown in the search results.


- Register for the training plan 'IDOH TB Basics and TB Tests Used to Identify TB Infection' by clicking the blue '+Register' button.

Viewing a Section


After clicking the 'play' button, the content will play automatically.

Upon completing a section, close the browser window.






Completing a Section


Return to the browser window with the Section 1 information.

- Click the green 'Mark Completed' button.
- A new button will appear click the green 'Take Evaluation' button.
 - You will be asked whether you completed a review of the section content.
 - Select yes or no
 - Click 'Next'
 - Click 'Close'
 - The section status will change to 'completed' **completed**



Completing a Section continued


- Click the red 'Back' button to return to the Training Plan.
- Click on 'Section 2: TB
 Basics' and repeat the
 steps used for section one
 to view the content.
 - Follow the same steps for 'Section 3: Testing for TB'.





Pre-requisites for Section Four

- There are several prerequisites the need to be met before section four can be accessed via the 'Launch' button.
 - For sections one through three:
 - the content needs to be viewed
 - the sections need to be marked 'completed'
 - a one question evaluation needs to be submitted






Launch the Assessment

- After viewing the content for section four, click the 'Mark Completed' button on the section four screen.
- If you are ready to take the final assessment, click 'ok' on the pop-up.
- Click 'start'





Take the Assessment

- The exam consists of 20 multiple choice and true/false questions randomly selected from a pool of many questions.
- An individual must receive a score of 80 percent or higher in order to pass the course.
 - Individuals may take the exam more than once if they do not achieve a passing score.
 - Upon passing the course exam, a certificate of course completion will be generated.



Final Evaluation

- Upon passing the assessment, the user will be asked to complete an evaluation.
 - Click the green 'Start' button.
 - Upon completing the evaluation, click the red 'Close' button in the upper-right hand corner of the screen.


