


EGFR Exon 20 Insertion Mutation and Lung Cancer


The Exon 20 mutation accounts for up to approximately 1 in 30 lung cancers.



Exon 20 mutations are more common among Asian Americans & never-smokers.

Exon 20 can be detected using **biomarker testing**.





Symptoms can be similar to other

EGFR lung cancer mutations, and can include **hoarseness, cough, chest pain and shortness of breath**.

New **targeted treatments** are available for this disease.
