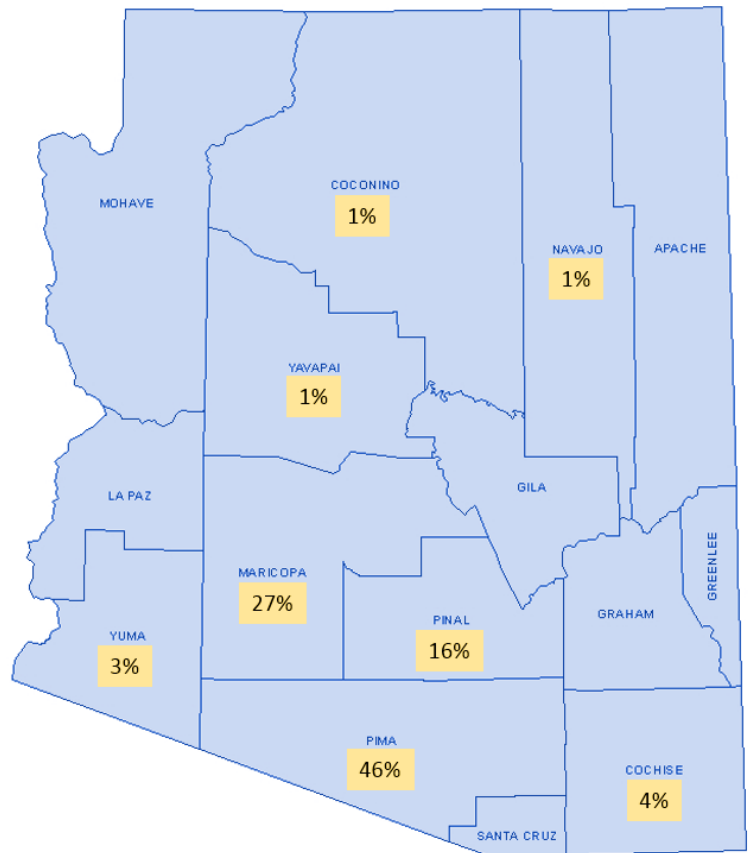

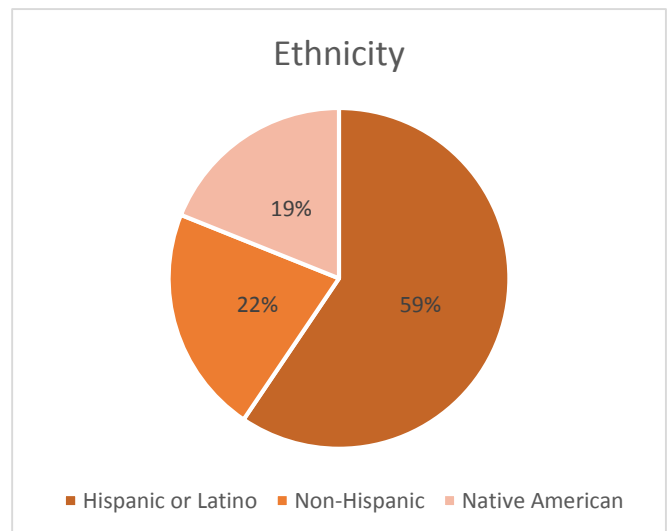


Table #3 Gender Distribution CNAW 2015

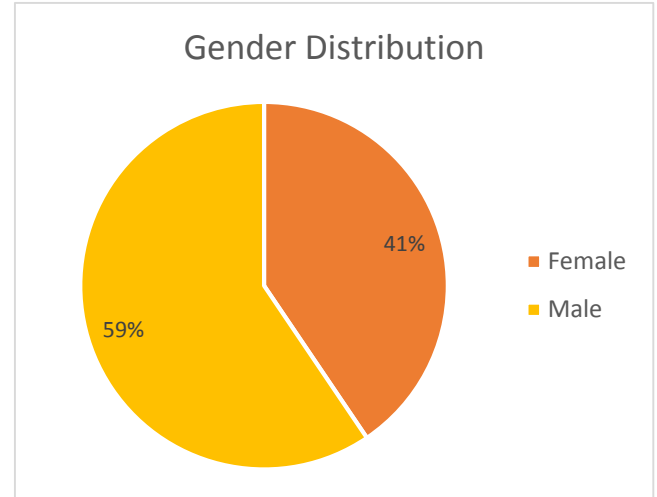

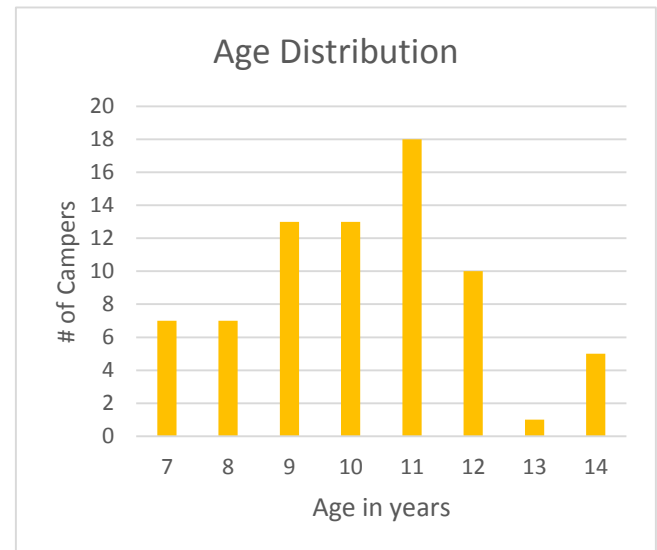
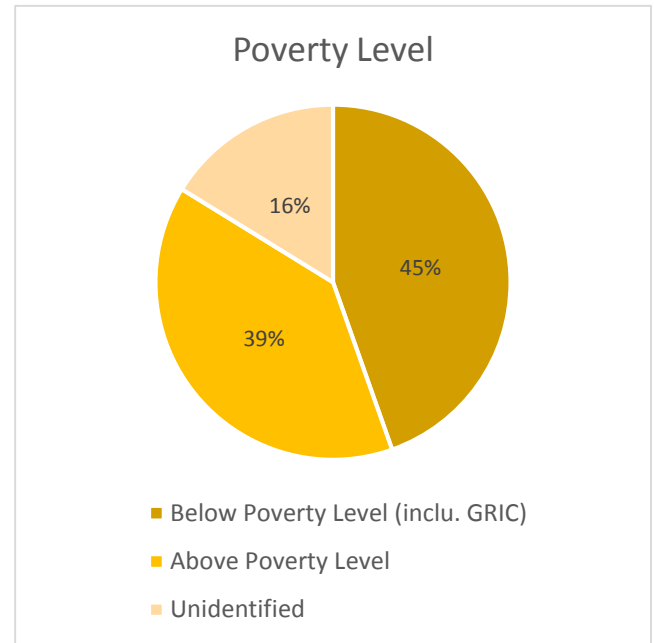

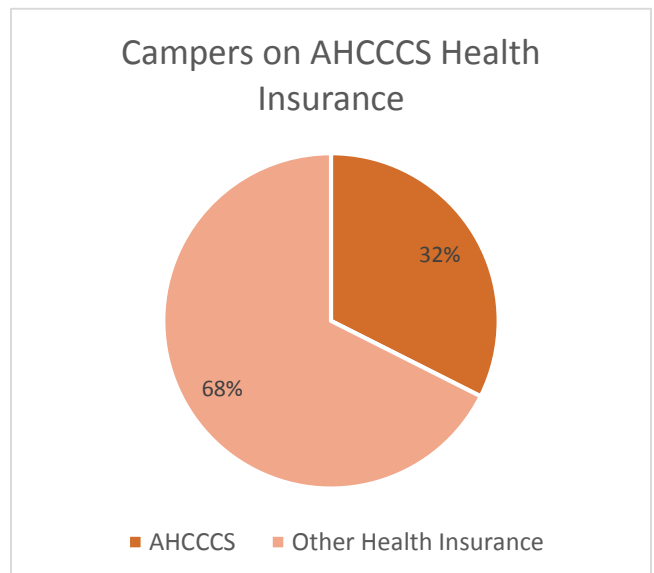

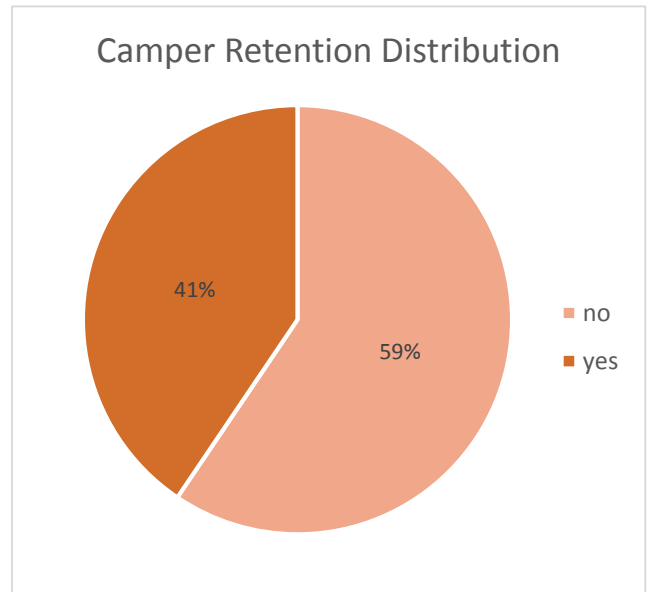
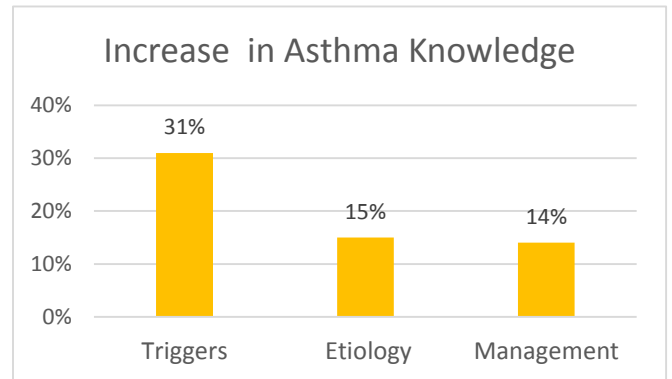


Table #9 Increase in Asthma Education in Campers CNAW 2015

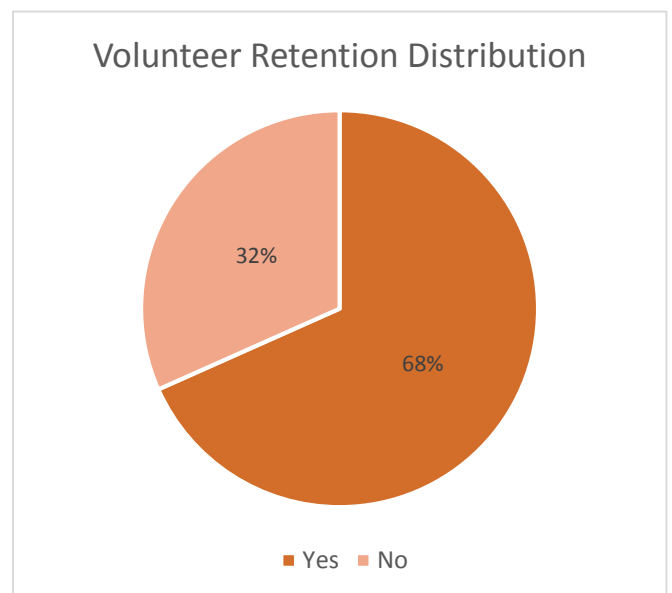
